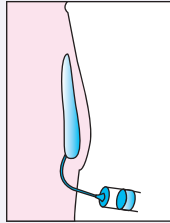


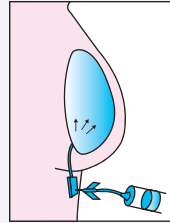
There are Implant Reconstruction Choices...

SINGLE STAGE RECONSTRUCTION

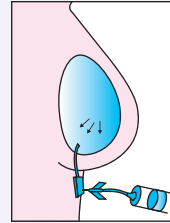
First surgery



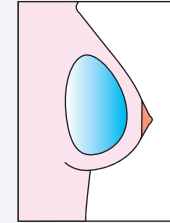
The expander/breast implant is placed in position.



Expansion of the implant is achieved by injecting saline through the injection dome.



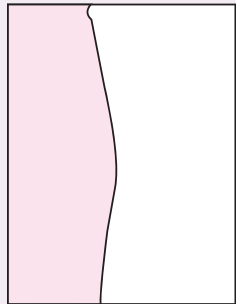
Final volume is achieved. The dome and fill tube are then removed in an office procedure.



Completed procedure.

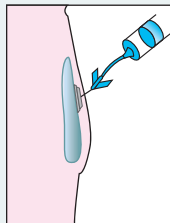
Single stage reconstruction may mean just one surgery.

THE PATIENT BEFORE SURGERY

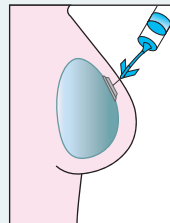


TRADITIONAL RECONSTRUCTION

First surgery

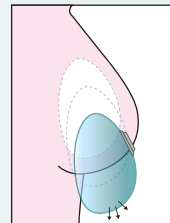


The tissue expander is placed in position.

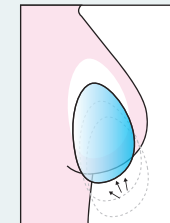


The injection dome is located. Expansion begins by injecting saline through the dome.

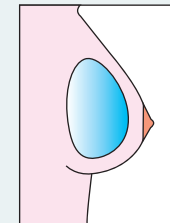
Second surgery



The tissue expander is now removed.



The implant is then placed in the expanded pocket.
